

Single Waste Hauler – Tentative Time Schedule (rev. September 29, 2009)

Initial Thoughts

- Are you interested?
- Savings in other communities that have gone to a single provider are about 50 percent. Example: Rochester Hills rates went from about \$90 per quarter to about \$45 per quarter.
- Given the size of the Bloomfield Hills customer base, approximately 1,500 dwellings it may be possible to have the City picked up in one or two days. Less disruption in neighborhoods. Less wear and tear on local roads.

Request for Bid & Instructions

- Seven year contract, beginning May 1, 2010 and ending April 30, 2017.
- Service would include solid waste, bulk, recycling and yard waste collection
- Contract would be awarded ~~January 12, 2010~~ March 9, 2010.
- Contractor would be responsible for billing and any customer complaints.
- Curbside recycling services for all single-family residences
- Recycling to multi-family residences in accordance with current practices at complex.
- Provide a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program

Itemized Bid & Instructions

- Contractor would provide rates for Curbside, Door side and Inside Garage Services.
- Contractor would provide a container for recyclable. Specification requires an 18 gallon container
- Contractor would be required to pick up bulk materials
- Contractor would provide on-call chipping / brush collection service. For single family homes.
- There would be a Senior Citizen discount available
- Customers can ask for service to be suspended when they are on extended leave.

Where Do We Go From Here?

4. Begin Bidding Process – ~~November 2009~~ December 2009 or January 2010.
