APPLICATION FOR RESIDENTIAL CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

The Michigan Residential Code (R110) requires that a Certificate of Occupancy be obtained from the Issuing Authority prior to use or occupancy of a building or structure. The Bloomfield Hills City Ordinance requires that an application for a Certificate of Occupancy be submitted to the Building Department after all final inspections have been completed and, when applicable, the final as-built grading plan for the subject property has been approved. These requirements must also be applied when a structure is occupied during construction and a Certificate of Compliance is requested by the Permit-holder. *This application must be submitted no less than two (2) business days prior to the requested date for the certificate.*
