



SOLICITING - WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS?

Solicitations cannot be prohibited but it can be regulated. Free speech is guaranteed by the United States Constitution and the State of Michigan. Report any force, coercion or intimidation to the Public Safety Department at 644-4200. You can get a sticker at the Clerk's Office to place on or near your front door if you do not wish to receive unsolicited information. You can request identification of any person soliciting at your residence. When Solicitors notify City Hall of their presence in the community, they are provided the list of residents that have requested ***NO SOLICITING*** at their residence. If you'd like your name and address on the ***NO SOLICITING*** list, complete the following form and mail to the City Clerk's Office at 45 E. Long Lake Road Bloomfield Hills, MI 48304 or fax to (248) 644-4813.

Remember: Certain religious, veteran, political and non-profit groups do have the right to solicit you. It is your decision whether or to listen or not.
